MALAYSIA TRIP | Red-carpet welcome for the premier in Kuala Lumpur; stage set for deeper strategic alignment

Trust India's strongest currency, says Modi

Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Saturday said India was seen as a 'trusted partner for growth' and it was reflected in the recent trade deals it has agreed with various countries, including the UK, the US and the EU.

Addressing a community programme in Kuala Lumpur, Modi said the Indian diaspora served as a living bridge between India and Malaysia and announced a new consulate in the archipelago nation and the Thiruvalluvar Scholarship to enable students to study in India.

Modi, who arrived in Kuala Lumpur on Saturday on a two-day visit, referred to the trade deals India agreed with various countries and said India is seen as a 'trusted partner for growth'. "Trust has become India's strongest currency," Modi said during the trade deals with the UK, UAE, Australia, the New Zealand, Oman, the EU and the US.

Malaysia is home to nearly three million people of Indian descent, the second largest in the world, with an overwhelming majority of Tamil origin. Greeting the Indian community members in different languages, PM made it a point to highlight the singing abilities of his Malaysian counterpart Anwar Ibrahim, particularly his love of Tamil songs of legendary actor-politician MG Ramachandran (MGR). "MGR is India's gift to the world. Tamil is not just eternal, and Tamil culture has served humanity with their talents," Modi said, recalling, India's Vice President CP Radhakrishnan and Union ministers S Jaisankar, Nirmala Sitharaman and L Murugan, were from Tamil Nadu. "The Tamil diaspora has been here for many centuries. Inspired by this history, we are proud to have established the Thiruvalluvar chair at the University of Malaysia. We will now set up our Thiruvalluvar Centre to further strengthen our shared heritage," prime minister said.

Modi said he was delighted to be in Malaysia, which is his first foreign visit in 2026. "India will always embrace you with open arms. That is why, just a few months ago, we took a historic decision to extend OCI card eligibility to Malaysian citizens of Indian origin up to the sixth generation," he said, adding, Malaysian prime minister Anwar Ibrahim was present at the event, and he have been friends ever before Ibrahim became PM. "India's success is Malaysia's success, and it is Asia's success," Modi said, adding, the guiding word of the relationship was IMPACT - India-Malaysia Partnership for Advancing Collective Transformation. The premier

grand red-carpet reception, with his Malaysian counterpart Ibrahim receiving him at the airport, signalling a new momentum in the bilateral ties. "Deeply touched by the warm welcome extended by my friend, Prime Minister Anwar Ibrahim at the airport, I look forward to our conversations and to further strengthening the bonds of friendship between India and Malaysia," Modi said on social media. "This is the third visit of prime minister to Malaysia, and the first after the elevation of the India-Malaysia bilateral relationship to a 'Comprehensive Strategic Partnership', in August 2024.

Earlier, Modi and his Malaysian counterpart received a rousing welcome at the event. Over 800 dancers showcased a treasury of Indian classical and folk dances, including Bharatanatyam, Kathak, Kathakali, Kuchipudi, Yakshagana, Lavani and Odissi. Modi and Ibrahim, who travelled to the venue in the same car, arrived on the stage amid slogans of 'Bharat Mata Ki Jai' and chants of 'Modi, Modi'.

An announcement was made the dance performance had entered the Malaysian Book of Records for the most number of performers in an Indian dance performance. "I am personally excited to have a great friend from India joining us in Malaysia," Ibrahim told the gathering. Malaysian prime minister recalled ancient ties between the two nations "long before embassies and trade agreements" came in vogue. "India or Bharat is among Malaysia's top trading partners. It is not only goods that move between us, but in 2025 over 10 million Indian visitors came to Malaysia," Ibrahim said. "I am proud to be a personal friend of Modiji and Indiji," Malaysian PM said.

Swedish blonde? Anil Ambani replied 'arrange that': Report

Jeffrey Epstein's sphere of influence among businessmen, politicians and academics also reached India, with the disgraced financier spending years cultivating a relationship with a section of nation's wealthiest family, according to documents released by US Justice Department, 'Bloomberg' reported.

Epstein's messages with the once-influential Indian businessman Anil Ambani stretch from 2017 through 2019, the documents show. The two men talked about world affairs, business and women, and made plans to meet in person. In 2017, Epstein placed orders for books about the Ambanis. "Who do you suggest," Ambani wrote on March 9 of that year, Epstein replied: "A tall Swedish blonde woman, to make it fun to visit."

"Arrange that," Ambani responded less than 20 seconds later. Text messages between Ambani and a phone number associated with Epstein also show them discussing getting together in Paris later that year — but missing each other — and chatting about the reaction to Trump at the World Economic Forum in Davos, Switzerland, in January 2018.

When Ambani said he planned to be in New York in May 2018, Epstein replied with an invitation to visit. "And if there are some people you would like to meet quietly. Let me know," Epstein wrote. Assistants confirmed a meeting between the two men at Epstein's home on the Upper East Side of Manhattan, the documents show. A representative for Ambani declined to comment. The digital books Epstein ordered on March 4, 2017 include Ambani & Sons and Storms in the Sea Wind: Anil Ambani V/S Ambani, according to thousands of emails obtained earlier by Bloomberg News. In the 2017 conversation with Ambani, Epstein asked about his preferences in women. The Indian mogul appeared to re-

said he did, jutting his impressions of Ambani and his family in a quick list. "V rich, V much wanting to be noticed, V celebrity conscious," Chopra said, adding, "Innumerable businesses" and "Brothers don't get along."

Epstein also asked businessman Tom Pritzker if he was close to Mukesh or Anil Ambani — "Don't really know either," Pritzker responded — and advised venture capitalist Peter Thiel to get to know Anil. A representative for Pritzker declined to comment, Chopra said and a representative for Thiel didn't respond.

positions before the House of Representatives oversight committee, probing the deceased financier's connections to powerful figures and how information about his crimes was handled. Democrats say the probe is being weaponised to attack political opponents of President Trump — himself a long-time Epstein associate who has not been called to testify — rather than to conduct legitimate oversight.

Holding the deposition behind closed doors, Bill Clinton said, would be akin to being tried at a kangaroo court.

"Let's stop the games + do this the right way: in a public hearing," the former Democratic president said on X.

Hillary Clinton, the former secretary of state, said the couple had already told the Republican-led oversight committee "what we know".

"If you want this fight... let's have it in public," she said.
