When the minister who is actually heading the department came to know of it, he informed the higher-ups in the government about the goings-on in the department. Now, there is pressure on the former minister to tell his assistant to return the cabbage that he has harvested from the department. But the former minister is averse to doing it and not ready to accept that his assistant ever shook the department down. The minister is unhappy after his department was changed. Now, remembers how he dipped his hands into gravy when he was heading the department.

Liquor trade

Besides having to face humiliation after his defeat, he spent a lot of money on contesting the election. There are reports that he may be fielded from his home constituency. Both his adversaries in the party and his well-wishers are in favour of his contesting the election. Keeping that in mind, the leader has started saying he is opposed to contesting the Lok Sabha election - though a group in the party still pitches him to be a candidate for the polls. Apart from that, because his family members are against this leader these days, many hurdles have got in his way to contest the polls, even if he wishes to.

For greener pasture

A few leaders of the Congress plan to switch over to the ruling party. Two leaders who lost the assembly election are ready to do the other side of the fence - the BJP. One of them, a former legislator, is in touch with the BJP for his entry in the ruling dispensation. The minister has assured that he will help him join the party. Because the former legislator was in the BJP, he is pulling out all the stops to return to the party fold, but another minister is disinclined to his comeback. The minister, aware of the former legislator's efforts to join back the party, is taking a crack at stopping him. Likewise, another Congress leader, keen on joining the ruling party, has contacted a senior leader of the BJP who, however, is in a dilemma over meeting the opposition leader. Such politicians feel the grass is always greener on the other side.

Bid to woo leader

Before the arrival of the new in-charge of the BJP's BMP unit many politicians are rigged out to please him. A few leaders in the party's state unit are acquainted with the in-charge. Some of them aspiring for tickets for the Lok Sabha election are also in touch with him, expecting his help to meet their demand. The in-charge has, however, hinted the ticket-seekers at his inability to help them. Many of them are also meeting the in-command in-charge seeking his help to get tickets. Likewise, many leaders of the party are also contacting the former in-charge with the object of getting a chance to contest the LS poll, but he, too, is giving a wide berth to such people. The in-charge of the party's state unit has barely any role in the election. He himself is calling up a few leaders to know of the political situation in the state to show his importance.

Spooky war room

The Congress's war room during the assembly election reminds many - especially those who have read The Canterville Ghosts of Oscar Wilde - of a haunted house. An American minister wants to buy it along with the ghost and furniture living there. We know the consequences. The Congress set up its war room for the assembly election in a house located in 74 Bungalows area in the state capital. The house has been allotted to the only Congress MP from the state since 2019. Locals say it is a haunted house and whosever lives there finds himself in political ruins. Once it was allotted to an in-charge officer, it was not known whether he imposed any tax on the original resident of the bungalow. Yet after his transfer to another place, the house was lying vacant. Afterwards, the in-charge officer's house was handed over to the Congress. The alleged ghost living in the house might have thought that it had a friend - though in the form of a politician - who is as old as he himself is, so he would no longer be lonely. Anyway, having to bite the dust in the election, the Congress decided to shift its war room to the party office. Now, the ghost is alone - though it is not known whether the wraith is still chasing them.

BJP to focus on constituencies it lost in Assembly polls

Clusters in-charge, Lok Sabha in-charge, conveners, and 'Vishakar' held a meeting in BJP office in Bhopal on Saturday. The clusters in-charge have been asked to organize meetings in Lok Sabha constituencies of their respective areas. Besides, focus has to be given on those constituencies in which BJP had had a clear defeat in Vidhan Sabha election. Lok Sabha in-charge have been asked to make booth wise ranking to identify which booth is strong and which is weak for BJP point of view. They have been asked to prepare list. Issues which are to be raised in elections at booth level, were discussed in the meeting. Progress of recently launched 'Gaan Chalo Abhiyan' was discussed in the meeting. All BJP leaders have been asked to move to villages under this Abhiyan.

'Target set to increase 10% votes share'

BJP state president VD Sharma, after the meeting, informed media that target has been set to increase 10 per cent share at booths. BJP had secured 53 per cent votes in 2019 General Election. This time, target is to increase it to 68 per cent to 70 per cent. All have been asked to work to win all 29 Lok Sabha seats, Sharma added.

BJP State Election Committee meeting may be held on Sunday regarding the vacant and lost seats in the Lok Sabha elections. Damoh, Morena, Narmadapuram, Sidhi and Jabalpur Lok Sabha seats have become vacant due to MPs becoming MLAs in the assembly elections. Chhindwara is the only seat on which BJP had to face defeat in the 2019 Lok Sabha elections.

A panel will be formed and sent for these six seats by the State Election Committee. For the remaining seats, work will be done as per the instructions of the central leadership of BJP. The candidates in the Lok Sabha elections will be selected entirely by the central leaders.

A meeting of the State Election Committee for Rajya Sabha elections is proposed on 7 January. Elections are to be held on 5 out of 10 seats. Out of these 5 seats, a panel will be formed from the state and sent to Delhi from where the names of the candidates will be announced.

Direct flight to Varanasi in summer schedule

DGCA releases summer schedule effective from March 31

The city is going to get air connectivity with Varanasi from March 31. This will benefit pilgrims as well as the business fraternity. The Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA) has released the proposed summer schedule of

flights to be implemented from the end of March. In direct flight, the direct flight to Varanasi is going to be added from the city, while the Rajkot flight is going to be stopped. It may be noted that the flight schedule is revised twice in a year by the DGCA. The first is from March end to October end, which is called the summer schedule. The second is from the end of October to the end of March, which is called the winter schedule. The DGCA receives proposals from airlines to con-

time flights on various routes, add new flights and discontinue existing flights, on the basis of which the DGCA issues the proposed schedule and takes approval from various airports and after that the final schedule is issued.

In the recently released proposed schedule, IndiGo has proposed to start a direct flight to Varanasi from the city and has not taken time for the Rajkot flight. This schedule will come into effect from March 31 and will remain effective till October 26.

Interim Budget reflects vision of prosperous India: Lalwani

MP Shankar Lalwani said that the Interim Budget takes forward Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision of a developed India by 2047 and sets the direction for the next 23 years, when the country will be celebrating a century of Independence. This budget is built on the basis of last year, in line with the Modi government's motto of 'Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas, Inclusiveness for the poor, youth, farmers and women, the MP added.

The budget highlighted the work done by the Modi government during the year of India's G-20 presidency, achieving the vision of a prosperous India with nature, modern infrastructure and equal opportunities for all, he said. Lalwani said that despite inheriting a broken economy with high non-performing assets and a depressed corporate sector, the Modi government implemented the targeted trinity of stimulating public investment, gradually increasing

capital expenditure outlay and providing targeted public services. Positive fiscal consolidation has been achieved through a balanced policy. "As a result of these proactive measures, the fiscal deficit is estimated to be reduced to 5.1% of GDP from 5.6% in the previous fiscal year. This puts the country in a position to complete fiscal consolidation by FY 2025-26, with the fiscal deficit expected to be below 4.5% of GDP," the MP said. To highlight the Modi government's efforts to transform India from a fragile pre-2014 economy to a world leader in economic management, the government will table a white paper before the Parliament to draw lessons from the previous period of mismanagement. Lalwani said that in line with the PM's vision of sustainable and long-term development, the budget for expenditure on important projects for the financial year 2024-25 has been increased to Rs 11,11,111 crore, which is equivalent to 3.45 of the country's gross domestic product.

Goods worth lakhs gutted in fire at cardboard factory

Goods worth lakhs were gutted after a fire broke out in a cardboard factory on Saturday early morning. No casualty was reported during the incident.

According to the fire brigade officer, the incident took place at Pratihaha Carton factory near toll plaza on Sanwer Road around 4.30 am. The people of the area spotted the fire and heavy

smoke and informed the police and the fire brigade. The fire fighters had to use more than 900 litres of water to control the fire. It took about four hours to completely extinguish the fire.

अक्टूबर 2014 से यह बिल्डिंग बन रही है, जिसे निगम आज तक पूरा नहीं करा पाया है

इंदौर। नगर निगम मुख्यालय परिसर में तैयार किए गए परिषद हाल में जल्द ही बैठक का श्रीगणेश होने वाला है। गुरुवार को ही नई बिल्डिंग में नए परिषद हाल का फीता मुख्यमंत्री डॉ. मोहन यादव ने काटा था। अब इस नए परिषद हाल में बैठक बुलाने की तैयारी हो गई है। इसको लेकर महापौर ने कहा कि एक-दो दिन में परिषद की बैठक बुलाने को लेकर तारीख तय करने के साथ एजेंडा जारी कर दिया जाएगा। नए हाल में परिषद की बैठक होने से अब निगम के 15 लाख रुपए बचेगे।
मुख्यमंत्री डॉ. यादव के हाथों तांबड़तोड़ नए परिषद हाल का फीता भले कल कटवा दिया गया, लेकिन इसकी बिल्डिंग

अब तक अधूरी है। अक्टूबर 2014 से यह बिल्डिंग बन रही है, जिसे निगम आज तक पूरा नहीं करा पाया है। नतीजतन 11 करोड़ 11 लाख रुपए में बनने वाली नई बिल्डिंग 21 करोड़ रुपए खर्च करने के बावजूद भी पूरी नहीं हुई है।
चार मंजिल का निर्माण अधूरा
अब भी 4 मंजिल का काम अधूरा है। चार में से तीन लिफ्ट लग पाई और रंगई-पुताई के साथ अन्य कई काम बाकी है। नए परिषद हाल का फीता काटने आए मुख्यमंत्री डॉ. यादव ने अधूरी बिल्डिंग को देख महापौर पुष्पमित्र भार्गव की चुटकी लेते हुए कहा कि मैंने तो महापौर को चमका दिया था। अभी समय नहीं है कार्यक्रम में नहीं आऊंगा, पर



उनके आग्रह पर आ गया। अब इस अधूरी बिल्डिंग को पूरा करने की हमारी जिम्मेदारी है, इसलिए बचा काम करने के लिए निगम को 50 करोड़ रुपए देने की घोषणा करता हूँ।

घोषणा होते ही सभी के चेहरे खिले
मुख्यमंत्री डॉ. यादव के 50 करोड़ रुपए देने की घोषणा करते ही महापौर भार्गव से लेकर एमआइसी मंबर और परिषद सहित अफसरों के चेहरे खिल गए, क्योंकि निगम की बिगड़ी आर्थिक हालत में यह राशि काफी हद तक मददगार साबित होगी। कार्यक्रम के कैलाश विजयवर्गीय ने परिषदों को पाठ पढ़ाया कि परिषद की बैठक में बिना वजह का हंगामा करने के बजाय विषय को पढ़कर आएँ और अपनी बात दमदारी से रखें। शहर की जनता ने हमें जिस काम के लिए चुना है, उसे करें न की हंगामा।
एजेंडा तैयार करने के निर्देश ..
एक-दो दिन में तारीख तय कर एजेंडा जारी कर दिया जाएगा। 15 फरवरी के पहले परिषद की बैठक बुलाई जाएगी। इसकी तैयारी करने को लेकर संबंधित अफसरों को निर्देशित कर दिया गया है। हालांकि नए परिषद हाल के बनने से अब निगम के हर बैठक पर खर्च होने वाले 15 लाख रुपए बचेगे। परिषद की बैठक ब्रिलियंट कन्वेंशन सेंटर और बड़ी होटल में होने के चलते यह राशि खर्च होती थी। अब सालभर होने वाली 6 बैठकों पर खर्च होने वाली 90 लाख की राशि बचेगी।

इंदौर। रेप का मामला राऊ थाना क्षेत्र का है। आरपी का नाम राजीव पिता रघुवीर सिंह निवासी नंद बाग कॉलोनी है। राऊ पुलिस के अनुसार पीड़िता ने बताया कि पति की मांगीपत् से परेशान होकर वह उससे अलग रहने लग गई थी। वह सिलाई का काम करती थी। इस दौरान कपड़े कटिंग का काम करने वाले राजीव से उसकी पहचान हुई। आरपी ने पीड़िता को शादी का झांसा दिया और एक साल तक लिव इन रिलेशन में रहे। इसी दौरान पीड़िता को पता लगा कि आरपी विवाहित है और उसके बच्चे हैं तो उसने उससे दूरी बना ली। आरपी इसके बाद पीड़िता को परेशान करने लगा। करीब दो माह पहले वह जब घर पर आकेली थी तब आरपी उसके घर में जबदस्ती घुसा, पीड़िता को बंधक बनाया और उसकी आबरू लूट कर धमका कर भाग निकला।

तांत्रिक क्रिया की आड़ में नाबालिग लड़की से दुष्कर्म, ढोंगी बाबा को 20 साल की सजा

इंदौर। खराब तबीयत ठीक करने के नाम पर तांत्रिक क्रिया की आड़ में नाबालिग लड़की से दुष्कर्म करने वाले ढोंगी बाबा को 20 साल के कठोर कारावास की सजा सुनाई गई है। थाना द्वारकापुरी में वर्ष 2020 में दर्ज प्रकरण में निर्णय देते हुए अपर सत्र न्यायालय ने आरोपित कृष्णा उर्फ श्याम बाबा को दोषी करार देते हुए सजा सुनाई है। पीड़ित बालिका को परिवार वाले तबीयत ठीक करने के लिए पूजा करवाने क्षेत्र के इस ढोंगी बाबा के पास ले गए थे। तांत्रिक क्रिया के नाम पर बालिका से आरोपित ने दुष्कर्म किया था। जिला अभियोजन अधिकारी संजीव श्रीवास्तव के अनुसार आरोपित 20 वर्षीय कृष्णा उर्फ श्याम बाबा निवासी इंदौर को धारा 376(2)(के) भादवी में 20 वर्ष के सख्त कारावास व 20 हजार रुपये के अर्थदंड से दंडित किया। अर्थदंड की संपूर्ण राशि प्रतिकर के रूप में पीड़ित लड़की को प्रदान करने का आदेश भी दिया। अभियोजन की ओर से पैरवी विशेष लोक अभियोजक सुशीला राठौर एवं विशेष लोक अभियोजक अमिता जायसवाल ने की। पीड़ित बालिका द्वारा 14 जनवरी 2020 को थाना प्रभारी द्वारकापुरी को शिकायती आवेदन प्रस्तुत किया गया था।

इंदौर। सराफा थाना क्षेत्र में कई व्यापारी बंगाली कारीगरों से सोना देकर जेवरात बनवाते हैं, यह पूरा व्यापार विश्वास किया जाता है, इसी बीच बंगाली कारीगरों से जोधपुर के एक व्यापारी ने करीब 4 किलो सोने की धोखाधड़ी की जिसके बाद पुलिस ने व्यापारी को गिरफ्तार कर लिया गया। इधर व्यापारी की पत्नी ने बंगाली कारीगरों के खिलाफ अपहरण करने की शिकायत भी कर डाली। सराफा पुलिस ने फरियादी शेखर इस्लाम पिता शेख युनुस निवासी सुभाष मार्ग की शिकायत पर जोधपुर के घोड़ा चौक स्थित मातेश्वरी ज्वेलर्स संचालक संजय उर्फ विशाल पिता जगदीश सोनी निवासी जूनी मंडी जोधपुर के खिलाफ 420 और 406 भादवी धाराओं में प्रकरण दर्ज

किया। सराफा थाने के चेनसिंह भदौरिया ने बताया कि बंगाली कारीगरों की शिकायत पर विशाल सोनी को गिरफ्तार किया गया और उसे 4 फरवरी तक पुलिस रिमांड लिया जाएगा। दरअसल 29 जनवरी को इंदौर के कुछ बंगाली कारीगर जेवरात की डिलेवरी देने जोधपुर पहुंचे थे इसी दौरान विशाल सोनी भी बंगाली कारीगरों के साथ इंदौर में अन्य काम होने के कारण आए थे, जब पूरे मामले में सब बंगाली कारीगर एकजुट हुए और समझ पाए कि उनके साथ धोखाधड़ी हो रही है तब बंगाली कारीगरों ने सराफा पुलिस को शिकायत की। इधर जोधपुर में विशाल की पत्नी ने पुलिस को पति के अपहरण की सूचना दी जिसके बाद जोधपुर पुलिस भी इंदौर आ पहुंची। यहां उन्होने सक्षमों को पकड़ा और पूछताछ के लिए साथ लेकर गए। हालांकि जोधपुर पुलिस सराफा थाना भी पहुंची थी।
